## Short Course VII on Surface Exploration for Geothermal Resources

United Nations University Geothermal Training Programme (UNU-GTP) in Iceland and La Geo S.A. de C.V. (LaGeo) in El Salvador will be hosting a "Short Course on Surface Exploration for Geothermal Resources", to be held in El Salvador during March 14-22, 2015. The course is tentatively planned as a one week course with lectures, field work, practical exercises, assignments and project team work.
